




A: Position of the Mist Fan Filter



Clean the doors of the Mist Fan Filter and the surrounding area.




Open cover on right and left side of the **GTX600** for cleaning cavities above the Mist Fan Filter.



B: Push and release. **C:** Open the cover.



Remove the Filter and clean the compartment.



Insert the new Filter and close the compartment.






Flushing Foams

The Carriage has to be moved to the right side of the **GTX600** to replace the Flushing Foam Set, Wiper Holder Supply Assy GTX6 and Cap Set GTX6 Supply.

Make sure to perform these three replacements **within 25 minutes** to prevent the print heads from drying out.





Replace both Flushing Foams like shown in the following pictures:


Make sure not to drop any white ink on parts used for CMYK or the other way around.



Position of the Flushing Foams




Remove the old Flushing Foam by using a waste cloth to avoid dripping ink into the **GTX600.**



After replacing the first Flushing Foam, clean your gloves with a cleaning cloth and then replace the second Flushing Foam.





Make sure that the Flushing Foams do not extend out off the outboard end portions of the maintenance unit.

If a Flushing Foam extends, it may result in non-ejection of ink-jet-droplets.

► After the work is completed press [OK] in the Menu and follow the instructions in the Menu.








Position of the Wiper Holder Supply Assies




- A: Clean the Shield Plate with a Cleaning Stick R.
- **B:** Check that the two hooks are snapped in.

Replace all Wiper Holder Supply Assies like shown in the following pictures:



- **A:** Push the latch on the left side of the Wiper Holder Supply Assy.
- **B:** Remove the old Wiper Holder Supply Assy.



- **C:** Insert the new Wiper Holder Supply Assy with thick foam facing to you and the latch to left.
- **D:** Make sure that the latch snaps into place.
- ► After the work is completed press [OK] in the Menu and follow the instructions in the Menu.




Check that all Rubber Caps are fixed on their metal plates.





Position of the Cap Sets




Carefully remove the Cap Set with a flat small screwdriver. Take care not to break the pins of the Cap Fixed Plate.




Clean the Cap Fixed Plate.

Take also care about the pins.




Cleaned Cap Fixed Plate








Carriage Foam Supply Assy

The Carriage has to be moved to the right side of the GTX600 to replace the Cap Set GTX6 Supply.

Make sure to perform these replacements within 25 minutes.





After the work is completed Press [OK]





Position of the Carriage Foam Supply Assy




Pull Carriage Foam downwards.

Do not touch the Nozzle Plates of the printheads.




Remove the Carriage Foam by using the sliders of Carriage Guides on right and left side.




B: Clean the Printhead and Nozzle Guards area, a small mirror is helpful.

C: Do not touch the Nozzle Plates. Repeat the operation on all four printheads.



C: Carriage Guides with sliding surface


D: Rear stoppers



The area **E** of the Carriage Foam should fit into the gap between the stoppers **D**.

The moving of the inserting must be stopped at the edges **F** by the stoppers.

▶ Side section view: **G:** Carriage; **D:** Stopper; **H:** Carriage Foam; **C:** Guide.



Wrong position of the Carriage Foam.




Correct position of the Carriage Foam.







Slide up the new Carriage Foam with the metal side facing up until it touches both rear stoppers



Attach the Carriage Foam to the magnets of the carriage.


D: Make sure that the Carriage Foam is correctly mounted and is not riding on the stoppers. Check that the foam plate has completely close contact to the carriage plate and that the nozzle plates protrude a little from the foam plate.





Replace maintenance unit parts

Carriage is Moving



- ▶ Check the condition of each Print Head with a nozzle test and perform, if necessary, a cleaning
- ► Finally close all covers of the **GTX600**
